On November 5, 2003, the Federal Election Commission notified your client of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). On January 7, 2005, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint, evidence presented in the responses, and information available to the public, that there is no reason to believe that Jordan Glatt violated the Act. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.
